OMMEGANG THREE PHILOSOPHERS The Belgian motto is “Strength in Union.” No phrase better describes Ommegang’s delicious Three Philosophers Quadrupel, which is a masterful blend of a strong, malty quadrupel ale and authentic Belgian Kriek from Brouwerij Liefmans in Oudenarde, Belgium. It’s the only beer of its kind in the world, and the high ABV and complexity of this beer make it a good candidate for ageing gracefully.

TASTING NOTES Three Philosophers is a dark, mysterious cherry-chestnut color with a smooth, tan head. Opaque but not cloudy. Flavors and aromas of roasted malt, dark fruits, vanilla, sweet and sour cherries, coffee, currants, brandied raisins, and chocolate. Notable sweetness and low bitterness with well-developed malts. Smooth but not syrupy. Mid-palate shows a soft malt center which gives way to a dry, warm, wine-like finish.

Brewed with pils, amber, caramel and Munich malt. Hopped with Styrian Goldings and Hallertau Spalter Select. Blended with Liefmans Kriek.
